

Postdoctoral Research Position in the Institute for Latino Studies

The Institute for Latino Studies (ILS) at the University of Notre Dame is seeking a Ph.D. to fill a postdoctoral research position in our new Center for the Study of Indiana Latinos. The Center is devoted to the collection, analysis, and dissemination of timely policy data to Indiana decision makers, community leaders, and the general public. The position is available on or after July 1, 2007 for an initial one-year appointment with the possibility of renewal.

The primary responsibility of the Postdoctoral Researcher will be to develop and submit research proposals to generate funding for the Center. In addition, s/he may also be called upon to assist the Institute's research department in support of broader research projects. Additional duties include writing articles for both academic journals and ILS publications and presenting findings at professional association conferences.

The preferred candidate is a social scientist with strong quantitative skills, proven writing skills, and the ability to see the story in numbers and tell it. Grant writing experience is a plus.
