Drawing inspiration from his father and guru, Prof. Balkrishna Upadhye, a noted violinist, Atulkumar's style represents a unique blend of Indian as well as Western technique. Atulkumar has received many awards, including the prestigious President's Award of All India Radio, and the title of Surmani by Sur Singar. He is a frequent performer on All India Radio and Doordarshan (India's national TV), and has performed at prestigious music festivals and at concerts all over the world, including at the Sawai Gandharva Music Festival in Pune, India, and in the US, UK, Switzerland, France, Germany, the Netherlands, and Spain, and other countries. In addition to his own performances, he has played duets with other leading musicians such as Ustad Shahid Parvez and Pandit Vishwa Mohan Bhatt (who have both performed at Notre Dame).
