Sanjay Subrahmanyan is one of India's leading exponents of the Carnatic style of music. After his initial training under V. Lakshminarayana and Smt. Rukmini Rajagopalan, Sanjay trained under the renowned master Kolkata Krishnamurthy. He is presently receiving guidance from the veteran nadaswaram maestro Semponarkoil SRD Vaidyanathan. A purist at heart, Sanjay strikes a fine balance between his technical virtuosity and artistic creativity and his exploration of ragas are endowed with an aesthetic expanse, his musical improvisations are forceful and his rendition of compositions are steeped in immaculate clarity of notes in a surcharged energetic voice. He has performed at many important international music festivals and institutions in Europe, USA, Australia, and Singapore. Sanjay's innate artistry and contribution to the art have won him well-merited recognition from various quarters and the latest in a long line of awards is the Best Senior Vocalist award from The Madras Music Academy.
