Exhibiting prodigious talent from an early age, she gave her maiden concert at the age of eight. She is highly regarded for her pure, aesthetic and intellectual style of singing. She received her Ph. D. in music from Andhra University, and her thesis, *Shaping of an Ideal Carnatic Musician through Sadhana* has been published by Gyan Publishers, New Delhi. She has performed in concerts and music festivals all over India, as well as in the US and South East Asia. She is recognized as an 'A' grade artist in vocal and 'B-High' grade artist in violin and viola by All India Radio. She has received numerous titles and awards, including 'Gayatri Sangeeta Vidwanmani', 'Best Pallavi Award' from The Music Academy, Chennai and 'Ragam Tanam Pallavi Award' from the Cleveland Tyagaraja Aradhana Festival.
