

LaPSI Meeting Minutes

April 21, 2017

- Activities for 2017 were identified and assigned.
 - Virginia and Anthony will look for speaker candidates.
 - Mark, Kendall and Anthony will review testing data spreadsheet and determine best methods to store, evaluate and present data. Consider Prism software.
 - Mark will develop agenda, lead meetings and prepare minutes.
 - Charlotte will attend Board meetings and communicate with Board.
 - Meetings in 2017 will be 4/21, 7/29 (tentative) and November.
- LaPSI filed paperwork as a non-profit corporation in Indiana. Three officers (Anthony, Ann, Diane). Looking into 501(c)(3) status. Annual reporting required. Community Service may be required. Grants may be easier to obtain with this status.
- Plants
 - Charlotte Hill will present on the plant study and other plant activities at the PPA annual meeting. General conclusion is that the lake is relatively healthy, but with a heavy curly-leaf pondweed population. Study recommended that fluridone should be applied earlier. Board is investigating Lilly pad situation.
 - LaPSI will investigate method and cost to monitor fluridone concentration after spring treatment.
 - Anthony will investigate glyphosate.
 - There was a question if other plants could be planted on levee downside.
- Chelsey's fluridone study is being reviewed. No ND interns for 2017. Anthony may find one for 2018 if needed.
- Omicron intends to donate in 2017, if feasible.
- Fish Study – PPA Board is studying recommendations. LaPSI not involved at this time.
- Wetlands – Arlene Corson is project leader for Board. LaPSI not involved at this time.
- Board has taken no action on harvester weed removal for 2017
