Once on campus the best way to reach the Observatory is to take the steps at the Main Entrance of Nieuwland Science Hall Observatory (across from LaFortune Student Center) to the 4th floor. Walk straight down the hall (just past Room 410) and to the left is a door leading to another flight of steps on the left (signs will be posted). Lastly, follow the steps up, turn left, and step onto Nieuwland's rooftop.

Unfortunately, the Observatory is ***not handicapped accessible***. However, arrangements can be made if anyone requires the need of an elevator and are then able to travel a flight of steps to the 5th floor.
