## Faculty Positions in Cell Biology and Physiology

The Department of Biological Sciences at the **University of Notre Dame** invites applications for two tenure-track faculty positions in the areas of cell biology and physiology. We seek to hire candidates with research expertise and interests consistent with our initiatives in cancer research, stem cell and iPS cell biology, endocrinology, and the neurosciences. A track record using animal and cell-based models to study disease or developmental processes is desirable. Hiring is expected at the Assistant Professor level, but exceptional mid-career candidates will be considered. Successful candidates will have a demonstrated record of research accomplishments and interest in collaborative and interdisciplinary research. Key research facilities include the AAALAC-accredited Freimann Animal Facility, Notre Dame Integrated Imaging Facility, Harper Cancer Research Institute, Center for Zebrafish Research, Eck Center for Global Health, Keck Center for Transgene Research, Center for Rare and Neglected Diseases, Center for the Study of Biocomplexity, and a Genomics Core. These faculty hires will also contribute to our teaching program at the undergraduate and graduate levels. The position includes an attractive salary, competitive start-up package, and laboratory space tailored to the applicant's research needs.
