Applicants must have a Ph.D., postdoctoral experience, and a demonstrated record of research excellence. We particularly encourage applications from ecologists who intersect with existing programmatic strengths in aquatic ecology, environmental change, and conservation biology. The successful candidate will be expected to develop a vigorous externally-funded research program and to contribute to the teaching mission of the department at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Notre Dame offers ecologists modern laboratory facilities in the Hank Center for Environmental Science, interdisciplinary activities supported by the Center for Aquatic Conservation, state-of-the-art instrumentation in the Center for Environmental Science and Technology, and a variety of field research and educational facilities at the Environmental Research Center.
