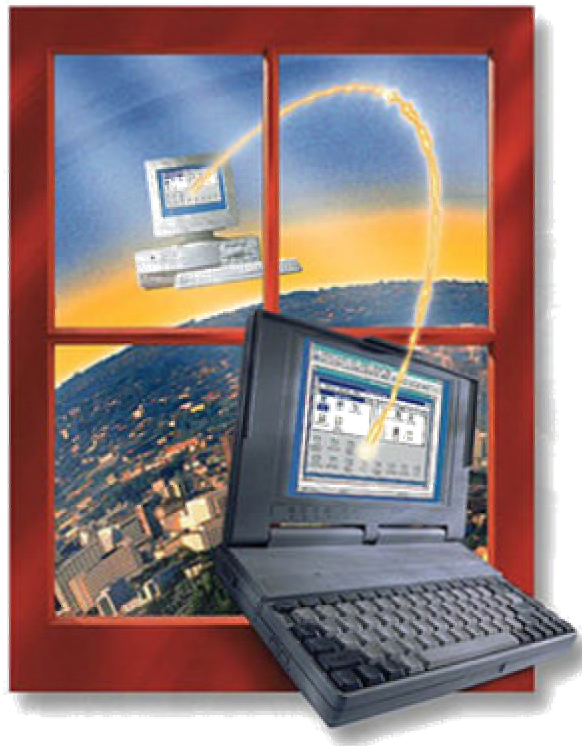

OUTSTANDING SCHOLAR

This provides special attention for high-achieving students applying for government jobs. It speeds the application consideration process and may shift consideration of your application for a GS-7 level (when otherwise would be considered for a GS-5 level).

- **GPA 3.5/4.0 and above** (3.45 rounds up to 3.5; 3.44 rounds down to 3.4)
- Graduated in upper 10% of class or major
- **MUST** state on your cover letter and resume that you: "Request Outstanding Scholar Consideration" or "Have Outstanding Scholar Qualification"
- **MUST** include transcripts with your application packet
