

# CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

We invite you to submit abstracts for inclusion in both the oral and poster sessions. Abstracts will only be accepted from individuals with a confirmed registration. **The deadline for registration and receipt of abstracts via email is Tuesday, May 15, 2007.**

## **Abstract Instructions:**

*Title:* The title (including spaces) should not exceed 150 characters. Capitalize the first word of the title and only proper nouns (i.e. protein names, dominant mutations) in the remainder of the title. Use Times New Roman, bold, size 14 for the title.

*Authors:* The first author **must** be the presenting author. Provide first name, middle initial(s), last name, departmental affiliation, institute name, city, state, and zip code for all authors. Use Times New Roman, size 12 for the authors and their affiliations.

*Abstract body:* Body of the text should not exceed 250 words. Do not include tables or figures in your abstract. Use Times New Roman, size 12 for the body of the abstract.

*Presentation preference:* Indicate a preference for platform (oral) or poster presentations. Postdocs and graduate students are encouraged to submit their abstract for consideration in the platform sessions. Abstracts not chosen for platform presentations will be placed into one of the poster sessions.

*Contact information:* The presenting author's email address should be included.

**Abstract submission.** All abstracts should be sent as either a Microsoft Word or PDF attachment to: **dhyde@nd.edu**. Please include "**Midwest Zebrafish Conference Abstract**" in the Subject line of the Email.

**Publication of abstracts.** An abstract book will be distributed to all meeting participants.

**Oral presentations.** The scheduled time for each oral presentation is 12 minutes, followed by a 3-minute discussion. Both Mac and PC computers will be available for Powerpoint presentations. Presentations on CD or memory sticks will be loaded onto the available computers. Do not plan to use your own computer. Please contact the organizers if you require additional audio/visual equipment.

**Posters.** All poster abstracts will be numbered and scheduled according to the session topics. Detailed information, including poster dimensions and schedule, will be sent with the acceptance letter and posted on the meeting website.
