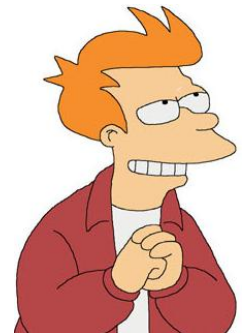
The More You Know
