- Serve as a liaison to The Shirt Project (\$500,000+ revenue operation) or the Student Businesses (Adworks, Irish Gardens)
- Sit on the Financial Management Board, which is responsible for allocating over \$850,000 in student activity fees, The Shirt revenue, and Endowment interest among various organizations, as well as administering The Shirt Charity Fund.
- This commitment requires approximately 5-6 hours per week and is a possible two-year commitment, as one assistant shall take over the role of Student Union Treasurer the following year.

This position would be a great experience for Finance and Accounting majors, but **all** majors are encouraged to apply! Don't miss out on this great chance for extra-curricular involvement!

This role is ideal for students who have decided not to travel abroad during the academic year.
