## NOTES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

*Contributions.* The journal is proactively edited by the Editorial Council, which selects the most pertinent topics to be covered and invites especially qualified authors to contribute. This is done with the advice of the Associate Editors. Although solicited, all contributions will be peer-reviewed and subject to editing by selected reviewers. The journal will not publish book reviews. Suggestions for topics, authors, and/or reviewers are welcome and should be submitted to the Editorial Office, indicated on the inside front cover of the journal.

*Manuscripts.* *A&PP* requires that all submissions conform to the requirements of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (Fifth Edition), which can be obtained from the American Psychological Association, Order Department, 750 First Street N.E., Washington, DC 20002-4242. It is also available in many bookstores and libraries.

All manuscripts should be submitted in four copies. No materials will be returned unless postage is provided. All submissions must be typewritten, double-spaced, on standard-size paper, 8-1/2 X 11 inches. Provide a separate title page including the following information: title; subtitle; all authors' names and affiliations; and the corresponding author's full mailing address, fax and telephone numbers, and e-mail address. These items must each be entered on separate lines, double-spaced, using normal capitalization and no underscoring. Each paper must begin with a 75-100 word abstract, followed by 5 to 10 key words. Authors are also encouraged to submit their final manuscript on a diskette along with a hard copy, identifying what software was used (WordPerfect or Microsoft Word in Windows or Macintosh formats are preferred).

*Tables, Figures, and Illustrations.* Authors are responsible for providing camera-ready copy of tables, figures, and illustrations with the submission of the article. Authors should be prepared to furnish such copy within two weeks after notification by *A&PP* that their article has been accepted for publication.

*Proofs.* First proof of an article will be sent to the lead or corresponding author, who will be expected to correct and return it to Elsevier Ltd., by airmail where appropriate, within 48 hours of receipt.

*Offprints.* Offprints can be purchased when orders are submitted with proofs. Reprints, ordered after an issue is printed, can be purchased at a 50 percent surcharge.

*Article Submission.* Submission of an article is taken to imply that it has not previously been published or is not being considered for publication elsewhere. If an author is publishing a related article elsewhere, this fact should be stated.

*Copyright.* Contributors of accepted articles will be asked to assign their copyrights to the publisher.
