In addition to these events planned by the JPW committee, other University departments and student groups will host supplemental events and receptions throughout the weekend. To register for JPW, either complete and return the enclosed ticket application, or submit an online ticket application at <http://jpw.nd.edu>. Submit your application by Monday, December 5th, 2011. Ticket applications submitted after this date will be charged a late application fee.

Seating for the President's Dinner and Closing Brunch is determined through a separate registration process. Your son or daughter will select up to two other families to join you at your table for these events. Each table seats a maximum of nine. Seating registration will be held the week of January 23rd, 2012. Further information regarding seating registration will be sent via e-mail to your son or daughter during the week of January 16th. Students will not be able to participate in seating registration unless their entire table group has registered and purchased tickets.

On Tuesday, February 14th and Wednesday, February 15th, your registered son or daughter will pick up a packet of information regarding JPW, including a detailed schedule of events and any tickets you have purchased. Any problems will be handled at that time. Tickets will also be available for pick-up beginning on Friday, February 17th in the JPW Hospitality Room located in LaFortune Student Center.

On behalf of the Junior Class and the JPW 2012 Committee, we would like to cordially invite you to join us in celebrating the 60th annual Junior Parents Weekend at the University of Notre Dame. The weekend will commence on the evening of Friday, February 17th, 2012, with the Opening Gala. Activities continue on Saturday, February 18th, 2012, with the Collegiate Workshops, Hall Luncheons, JPW Mass and the President's Dinner. The weekend concludes on Sunday, February 19th, 2012, with the Closing Brunch.

Junior Parents Weekend is focused on the Notre Dame family, enabling you to become part of the academic, spiritual, social, and residential life of the University. It provides you with the chance to learn more about the people and places that comprise your son or daughter's home away from home. Included in this mailing is a general itinerary for the weekend and information on how to apply for tickets to the Gala, Dinner and Brunch. Due to the large size of our class and popularity of JPW, we anticipate filling the Joyce Center to its capacity for these events. With this in mind, we are obligated to limit the number of tickets for each event to **three per junior, including the junior**.

There are two ways to submit a ticket application this year. For credit card purchases, you may submit an online ticket application through the JPW web site: <http://jpw.nd.edu>. To pay by check or money order, you may submit the enclosed paper ticket application. In either case, we ask that you submit a ticket application with payment as soon as possible, but no later than **Monday, December 5th, 2011**. Late applicants will be charged an additional late ticket purchase fee, and due to the anticipated attendance, may be seated in a secondary dining area. Please be sure to fill out your application completely, including your son or daughter's NetID and ndID#. Remember, this application is for your entire party, so please include your son or daughter in your ticket order and payment. Your student will be notified the week of January 16th, 2012, regarding the details of seating registration. Payment must be complete in order for seating assignments to be given. Also, it is important that the JPW organizers are aware of any families with special needs so that we may assist you in any manner that you require. If you have not yet made travel arrangements for this event, we invite you to contact Anthony Travel at 1-800-366-3772, or the South Bend/Mishawaka Convention and Visitors Bureau at 1-800-519-0577. We will also be holding a lottery for rooms at the Morris Inn, with the drawing to take place in late November. Each winner of the lottery will be guaranteed a room at the Morris Inn for the nights of Friday, February 17th and Saturday, February 18th. Winning families are responsible for all payments to the Morris Inn. Please e-mail the Morris Inn at wwinovic@nd.edu or fill out a request form in person at the Morris Inn by Sunday, November 20th to enter this lottery.
