



**Game Developers Conference in San Francisco -- March 7, 2007
Bostjan Cadez is one of three recipients for best game of the year.**

Line Rider is a Flash game originally created in September, 2006 by Boštjan Cadež (also known as fšk), a Slovenian university student. Originally appearing on deviantART on September 23, 2006, Line Rider quickly became an Internet phenomenon. In the week ending on 16 October 2006, it was the seventh-quickest gaining keyword in Google.

“This is the awards show that maps closely to the Oscars because all the nominations come from the community and all voting comes from their peers,” said Jamil Moledina, executive director of the Game Developers Conference. “(Cadez) is in very strong company.”

The games are expected to ship by next spring. But every game will include the original “toy,” as Cadez calls it, with no scoring and no frills. As part of the agreement, the company will split proceeds with Cadez.
