This code section is published in the 2000 edition of U.S.C. (The 2006 edition of Title 49 is not published yet.) An amendment is contained in the 2005 cumulative annual supplement (Supp. V) to the 2000 edition.

32 U.S.C. § 708 (2000 & Supp. V 2005).

This code section appears in the bound volumes of the unofficial codes. However, a 2007 amendment to certain subsections is only available in the pocket parts of the unofficial codes. The new amendments are too recent to appear in the official U.S.C., so you must cite an unofficial code.
