 Citing a book with more than two authors to a specific section.
4. National Center for State Courts, Court Improvement Programs: a Guidebook for Planners 230-36 (1972).
 Citing a book with an institutional author to a specific span of pages.
5. 2 Kenneth Culp Davis & Richard J. Pierce, Jr., Administrative Law Treatise §10.3, at 124 (3d ed. 1994).
 Citing a multi-volume work with two authors to a specific page, within a specific section, within a particular volume.

 Citing to the Second Restatement.

Citing to a specific sub-section in the Third Restatement.
