

Locating a book, report, or essay in a book

At Law Library?

Search the [ND Law Catalog](#) – unless absolutely certain of title, use keyword search



At other ND libraries?

Search [Main Library catalog](#) – title keyword best if any doubt about title



On web?

Search [GOOGLE Books](#) – might find PDF version (or web might be the only source)



Available ILL?

Search [WORLD CAT](#) – keyword best unless certain of title; if record found, do [ILL request](#)



Still no luck?

Search **full-text law review on [WL](#) or [LX](#)** – compare footnote(s) citing same source to check spelling of author's name and exact title. Once discrepancy identified, start process above over again.



Give up?

Locating a journal article

Available in PDF?

- A. For legal journals check [HeinOnline](#)
- B. If non-legal journal, try Main Library's [e-Journal Locator](#)



Print journal available at ND?

- A. Search [ND Law Catalog](#) for journal (*not* article) title – unless absolutely certain of title, use keyword search to locate journal
- B. Search [Main Library catalog](#) – use "[All Journals](#)" link under **e-Journals** tab



On the web?

Search [GOOGLE Scholar](#) – might find PDF version (or web might be the only source for online journals)



Available ILL?

Search [WORLD CAT](#) – keyword best unless certain of title; if record found, do [ILL request](#)



Still no luck?

Use an [index](#) to check accuracy of citation.
Or search **full-text law review on [WL](#) or [LX](#)** – compare footnote(s) citing same source to check spelling of author's name and exact title. Once discrepancy identified, start process above over again.

B. Check [other Newspaper databases](#) at:

Search [Main Library catalog](#) for Newspaper (*not* article) title – unless absolutely certain of title, use keyword search

Search [GOOGLE News](#) – might find PDF version (or web might be the only source... recent or “breaking” news stories might be “web exclusives”)

Will not have PDF, but at least you can verify the citation while waiting for ILL copy to arrive !

Search [WORLD CAT](#) – keyword best unless certain of title; if record found, do ILL request **AND BE SURE TO INCLUDE:**

- Author & Title
- Page / Newspaper Section
- Day, Month, Year (Volume, Issue (if known))

Search **full-text law review** on [WL](#) or [LX](#) – compare footnote(s) citing same source to check spelling of author’s name and exact title. Once discrepancy identified, start process above over again.
