

**Learning Resource Center (LRC)  
Programs for Mathematics Courses

The Learning Resource Center in the First Year of Studies provides Math assistance to all interested first year students free of charge. LRC programs include group tutoring, collaborative learning, and help sessions to assist students with their proficiency in Math. Sessions will be available beginning the first day of classes. **Tutoring:** The purpose of the tutoring program is to enable first year students to receive assistance from reliable and knowledgeable upper-class level students. The tutors provide instruction in specific content areas in which they have a level of expertise. Tutoring sessions are restricted to small groups of students for enhanced learning.
