Offer Tracking: As you receive offers and acceptances, please enter them on-line via InsideND, <http://inside1.cc.nd.edu> OR fill out a form in our office. This will help us to:

- Give you current information on where your class stands [aggregate only; your name will not appear in conjunction with any of the published data except on an end-of-year list of acceptances].
- Adhere to the standards set by our national professional association whereby all accredited business schools are required to know the job employment status of all of their students by mid-summer.
- See how you're doing and how we can be of help to you. You will receive an email from a CD team member monthly throughout the semester to help us determine your status and see how we can help.
