## On campus:

- 1. LaFortune student center. Inside are **Buen Provecho** (like Taco Bell), **Burger King**, the **Huddle Mart** (convenience store), **S'barro**, **Starbucks**, and **Subway**.
- 2. **Legends** south of the stadium. \$6 10. Vegetarian (and vegan?) options. Campus bar serving burgers and other bar food.
- 3. **Recker's** behind South Dining Hall. \$6 8. Vegetarian and vegan options. Sandwiches, soup, burgers, and pizzas.

## Off campus but in walking distance:

- 1. Between the Buns 1803 South Bend Ave. \$5 10. A sports bar serving burgers, wings, etc.
- 2. Dominic's Pizzeria 1640 South Bend Ave. \$6 17. Vegetarian options. Thin crust pizza.
- 3. **J. W. Chen's** 1835 South Bend Ave. Lunch \$5 6. Dinner \$7 14. Vegetarian and vegan options. Tasty Chinese food.
- 4. K's 1733 South Bend Ave. \$5 approx. Hot dogs and other bad-for-you-but-delicious things.
- Lula's 1631 Edison. \$6 8. Vegetarian options. A coffee shop serving sandwiches, soups, and salads. Tasty.
- 6. Martin's 2081 South Bend Ave. Vegetarian and vegan options. \$4 8. A grocery store with a large deli. The deli offers sushi, panini, sub sandwiches, soups, a salad bar, fried things, and a Starbucks. This is a bit of a long walk to attempt over lunch.
- 7. Rico's Filling Station 1841 South Bend Ave. \$4 6. Vegetarian options, vegan upon request. Cajun, Caribbean, and Southwestern food. Nothing fancy but pretty good and pretty cheap. The cubano sandwich is a favorite.
- 8. Studebagels 1801 South Bend Ave. \$2 5. Vegetarian options. Bagels and things on bagels. Yum.
- 9. **Thai Lao** 1835 South Bend Ave. \$5 8. Formerly a very cheap and interesting Thai restaurant. A recent change of ownership raised prices and toned down the decor, greatly reducing the appeal of the place.

## Others:

- 1. American Pancake House 508 N. Dixie Way, South Bend and 1008 W. McKinley, Mishawaka. \$4 8. Vegetarian options. A diner serving breakfast and lunch.
- 2. Barnaby's 3724 Grape Road, Mishawaka and 713 E. Jefferson, South Bend. \$5 20. Vegetarian options. Good pizza, sandwiches, and a bar. A good place to take a crowd.
- 3. Bruno's Pizza 119 Dixie Way North. \$8 18. Vegetarian options. Popular local pizzeria.
- 4. Cambodian Thai 229 S. Michigan. \$6 8. Vegetarian and vegan options. A tiny restaurant (don't even try to get a party of more than 5 people seated) offering good food at good prices (servings are more than ample). I recommend the coconut chicken soup, somtum, and drunken noodles. Or, if you feel you need more lemongrass in your diet, try the planet lemongrass chicken curry.
- 5. Chicory Cafe 105 E. Jefferson. \$6 8. Vegetarian and vegan options. A New Orleans style cafe. Po' Boy sandwiches, a tasty muffuletta, soups, and really good beignets.

- 6. Elia's 115 N. Dixie Way. \$8 15. Vegetarian and vegan options. Lebanese food, very good. The vegetarian platter is one of the best vegan meals in town and the array of grilled meats should please any carnivore. Dessert offerings include cashew, pistachio, and walnut baklava, all of which are very tasty.
- 7. La Esperanza 1636 N. Ironwood. \$7 11. Vegetarian (and vegan?) options. Mexican food.
- 8. The Fiddler's Hearth 127 N. Main St. \$8 16. Vegetarian options. An Irish public house with an extensive selection of beer on tap and live music most nights. The food is good and the kitchen is open 'til 11. This place is small and gets packed by about 9.
- 9. **The Great Wall** 222 S. Dixie Way. \$8 15. Vegetarian and vegan options (you should be careful with the vegetarian section of the menu, though). Pretty good Chinese food.
- 10. **Hey Sushi** 515 N. Dixie Way (in the Quality Inn). \$7 and up. Vegetarian and vegan options. The South Bend branch of the popular Chicago sushi bar.
- Mishawaka Brewing Co. 3701 N. Main, Mishawaka. \$9 20. Vegetarian and vegan options. A microbrewery offering standard brew-pub fare.
- 12. The Mishawaka Chains. Along Grape Road or Main Street from Edison to Cleveland you'll find TGI Friday's, Papa Vino's, Olive Garden, Panera, Chipotle, Max and Erma's, and more.
- 13. Polito's 4615 Grape Road, Mishawaka. \$8 14. Pizza, pasta, and other Italian-American standards.
- 14. Rio's 1724 N. Ironwood. \$6 8. Vegetarian (and vegan?) options. Mexican food.
- 15. **Seoul Garden** 1628 E. McKinley Ave., Mishawaka. \$8 18. Korean and Japanese food. An enormous menu including many authentic dishes for the adventurous. The bi bim bop and barbecue are good.
- 16. Siam Thai 211 N. Main St. \$9 14. Vegetarian and vegan options. A very nice place with friendly, efficient service. Probably the best Thai food in town (though I prefer the drunken noodles at Cambodian Thai).
- South Bend Chocolate Cafe 122 S. Michigan. \$?. Sandwiches and salads. Also chocolates, sundaes, and cheesecake.
- 18. **The Star of India** 3915 Grape Rd., Mishawaka. Lunch buffet \$? Dinner \$9 12. Vegetarian and vegan options. Good Indian food.
- Sunny Italy Cafe 601 N. Niles Ave. \$10 20. Vegetarian options. Family style Italian Restaurant. Great meatballs.
- 20. Taj 508 W. McKinley, Mishawaka. Lunch buffet \$7 or 8. Dinner \$9 13. Vegetarian and vegan options. Good Indian food. I like the Taj a little better than the Star but some people disagree.
- 21. **Toyo Grill** 620 W. Edison #106, Mishawaka. \$4 20. Vegetarian and Vegan options. Sushi, tempura, and other Japanese and Korean dishes. Everything I've had here has been good but I especially recommend the vegetable tempura.
