 - PSA member with a level IV ranking, certified synchronized team rating

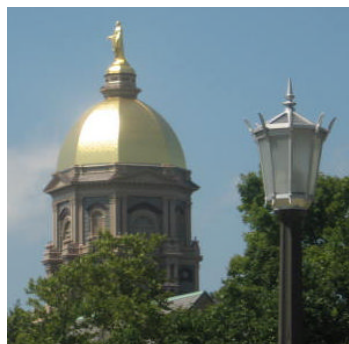
- ☘ Board

What does the team do?

- ☘ Synchronized skating
 - Holds weekly practices during the school year
 - Performs at Notre Dame hockey games and local ice shows and exhibitions
 - Competes in local and qualifying competitions



☘ Intercollegiate skating – **NEW!**

- Travels to intercollegiate competitions
- Individual events (short program/compulsory program, long program, dance)
- Team events (team maneuvers)

☘ Club activities

- The club holds a concession stand for a home football game
- NDFSC exhibition to be held during the fall semester to showcase team and individual skating
- Club social events (team dinners, end-of-year awards dinner, etc.)



When are practices?

- ☘ Tuesday: 9:00-10:45 pm
- ☘ Thursday: 9:00-10:15 pm
- ☘ Sunday: 4:00-5:45 pm
- ☘ Plus off-ice each week



What are the expenses?

- ☘ There is an annual fee to cover
 - ice time
 - competition fees
 - tights, makeup
 - travel
 - dresses and warm-ups
- ☘ The team holds two fundraisers to help defray costs

Who can join the team?

☘ Anyone from Notre Dame, Saint Mary's, or Holy Cross who wants to skate!

☘ To compete on the synchronized team:

- no synchro experience is necessary
- must have passed juvenile moves in the field

☘ To compete in intercollegiate events:

- must have passed at least Pre-Preliminary Freestyle (USFS) or Freestyle 3 (ISI)
- no requirements for dance events

Who is on the team?

☘ Levels range from pre-preliminary to senior

☘ Hometowns span the country from east coast to west coast, and everything in between

☘ Academic majors from all four colleges—Science, Arts & Letters, Engineering, and Business
