**2006 INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

GUIDELINES

1. The number of scholarships awarded each year is based on interest income generated by the International Scholarship Award Fund. There will be one \$3,000 U.S. International Exchange Scholarship awarded in the 2006 competition.
2. The International Scholarship may be used to pay for travel, living, and incidental expenses in order to pursue a one semester or a summer course of study at a law school located in a country different from where the candidate's current law school is located.
3. Prior winners of International Exchange Scholarships or Balfour Scholarships are precluded from entering subsequent competitions.
4. Any active Phi Delta Phi member who has completed one full year of legal study, who was initiated into the Fraternity on or before June 30, 2006 and who did not compete for a Balfour Scholarship is eligible to compete.
5. The course of study must be pursued during the summer of 2007 or during the 2007-2008 school year.
6. Candidates shall indicate in the application form the law school they plan to attend, and submit evidence of sufficient knowledge of the language of that law school's country or province.
7. Each Inn will submit the original Form BSA/ISA-I to its Province President on or before October 23, 2006. International Headquarters will be notified of the Inn's nominee on the enclosed form (BSA/ISA-II). NOTE: Please Note that the Application Forms BSA/ISA-I and BSA/ISA II serve as application forms for the Balfour Scholarship and the International Exchange Program, and the Balfour Minority Scholarship competitions. Every entry shall be accompanied by a brief biographical sketch.
8. **The Court of Appeals will determine the recipients of the International Exchange Scholarship based on scholastic merit.** The Court of Appeals will take into consideration class rank, number of students in the class, and difficulty of the law school program, and foreign language proficiency. If several candidates are comparable in scholarship, the Court may take into consideration other activities within the law school, or without, which reflect on the quality of the student's scholastic achievement.
9. Each Inn may select up to three candidates. Selection procedures shall be consistent with the general International Scholarship objectives and shall be incorporated into the Inn Bylaws prior to candidate selection. The Dean of the law school shall certify the good academic and class standing of each of the Inn's candidates. ***Failure to submit such certification, or an explanation of why certification is not possible, will result in AUTOMATIC disqualification.***

10. The Province President has the responsibility for selecting a committee (made up of two Phi Delta Phi Barristers and the Province President) which will be responsible for selecting the Province candidates.

Upon receipt of the applications the Inns, the committee will choose no more than three candidates from among those submitted, and will submit the Committee's choice or choices to International Headquarters on or before November 27, 2006. Entries will be duplicated and mailed to the Court of Appeals.

11. The Court of Appeals will select winners in the competition. There is no requirement that there be any scholarship winners in a given year or that each Province have scholarship winners.
12. Candidates and Inns will be notified of the scholarship winner on or before January 31, 2007. Before the check is sent to the winner, Fraternity Headquarters must receive (a) a letter from the law school chosen by the winner confirming admittance of the winning candidate to the course of study and (b) a letter from the Phi Delta Phi Inn at the law school confirming that members of the Inn will provide housing for the winner.
13. Within thirty days of the end of the course of study, a letter from the chosen law school confirming that the winner completed the course of study with satisfactory attendance must be filed with Fraternity Headquarters. ***IF NOT DULY FILED, THE WINNER WILL BE OBLIGATED TO REIMBURSE THE AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP TO THE FRATERNITY.***
