

SUMMER SESSION 2010 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1) Q: What is the summer session web site?

2) Q: When are summer session classes for 2010 available on the web?

A: Summer session classes will be available March, 2010. Notre Dame students can search for summer courses through insideND. Non-Notre Dame students can use the link on the registrar's homepage at <http://registrar.nd.edu/> to access class search.

A: Registration begins on Wednesday, March 17, 2010, at 7 a.m. for current Notre Dame students.

A: After Wednesday, March 17, 2010, at 7 a.m., individuals can apply by using the "Online Course Application" link (<http://www.nd.edu/~sumsess/application.html>).

5) Q: What is the first class day for summer session 2010? **OR**

Q: When does summer session begin?

A: The first class day for the traditional seven week summer session is Tuesday, June 22, 2010. However, there are a number of special classes that begin earlier or later than June 22, 2010. Please pay attention to the detailed information within Class Search to find the actual start & end dates of a course you are interested in.

6) Q: What is the last class day?

A: The last class day for the traditional seven week summer session is Friday, August 6, 2010. However, there are a number of special classes that end earlier or later than August 6, 2010. Please pay attention to the detailed information within Class Search to find the actual start & end dates of a course you are interested in.

7) Q: What is the Final Exam date?

A: Final Exam date is your last class day. Please pay attention to the last class date/final examination date the instructor provides to you during the course.
