Sensitivity

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Definition & Problem Example

- Does a change in coefficient effect the value of the Objective Function? (as opposed to the basis)
- Tweaking coefficients for possible differences in data

Approaches

- Brute Force
- Classical Sensitivity Analysis
- Computer Based Ranging





Figure 6.2: Changing a coefficient in the objective function tilts it. (a) original objective function. (b) a tilt which does not change the optimum basis. (c) a tilt which changes the optimum basis.




Figure 6.3: Changing a right hand side may not affect the optimum at Figure 6.4: Why the basis changes outside all.
